#### **Discussing God's Word**

- 1. Why did Peter lead the others to return to fishing?
- 2. Why did the disciples not recognize Jesus at first?
- 3. Why did Peter jump out of the boat to go meet Jesus?
- 4. What was the significance of Jesus eating with the disciples?
- 5. Why did Jesus ask Peter three times if he loved Him?

# Applying the Word

- 1. What do we tend to do when we are unsure or are afraid?
- 2. Why is Peter's response to Jesus' presence especially instructive to us in revealing how we should respond to Him?
- 3. Why is Jesus' way of patiently proving of Himself to the disciples such a comforting thing?
- 4. How does Jesus' restoration of Peter give us hope for when we deny Him?

# **Praying The Word**

- » Pray that the Lord will help us run to Him and not to our earthly comforts when we are afraid.
- » Pray that the Lord will help us run to Him with abandon when He reveals Himself to us.
- » Praise the Lord for proving Himself to us over and over without growing impatient or weary.
- » Ask the Lord to give us confidence in the knowledge that He will restore us like he restored Peter when we deny Him.
